



The 1961 Convention on Narcotic Drugs, which was expanded and strengthened by the 1972 Protocol, is considered a major achievement in international drug control because it consolidated all previous conventions and streamlined the international drug control machinery. The 1961 Convention establishes strict controls on the cultivation of opium poppy, coca bush, cannabis plant and their products, which, in the Convention, are described as "narcotic drugs" (although cocaine is a stimulant drug rather than one that induces sleep). Control is exercised over 119 narcotic drugs, mainly natural products, such as opium and its derivatives, morphine, codeine and heroin, but also synthetic drugs, such as methadone and pethidine, as well as cannabis and coca leaf.

The 1971 Convention on Psychotropic Substances was adopted to curtail the diversion and abuse of certain psychotropic substances, such as central nervous stimulants, sedative-hypnotics and hallucinogens, which had resulted in public health and social problems in some countries.

It is our intention to assist our customers to meet the information obligations set by International Narcotics Control Board's Yellow List, Annex to Forms A, B and C, 52th edition, December 2013 and INCB's Green List, 25th edition, January 2014. To the best of our knowledge the following products of Covestro Deutschland AG do not intentionally contain substances listed on the Narcotics Control Board Yellow List and Green List and therefore these substances are not expected to be present above limit values, if applicable. The presence of analytically detectable traces, which have possibly been introduced via raw materials, auxiliaries and additives, cannot be excluded. Specific analyses to measure such traces have not been performed on raw materials or final products.
